

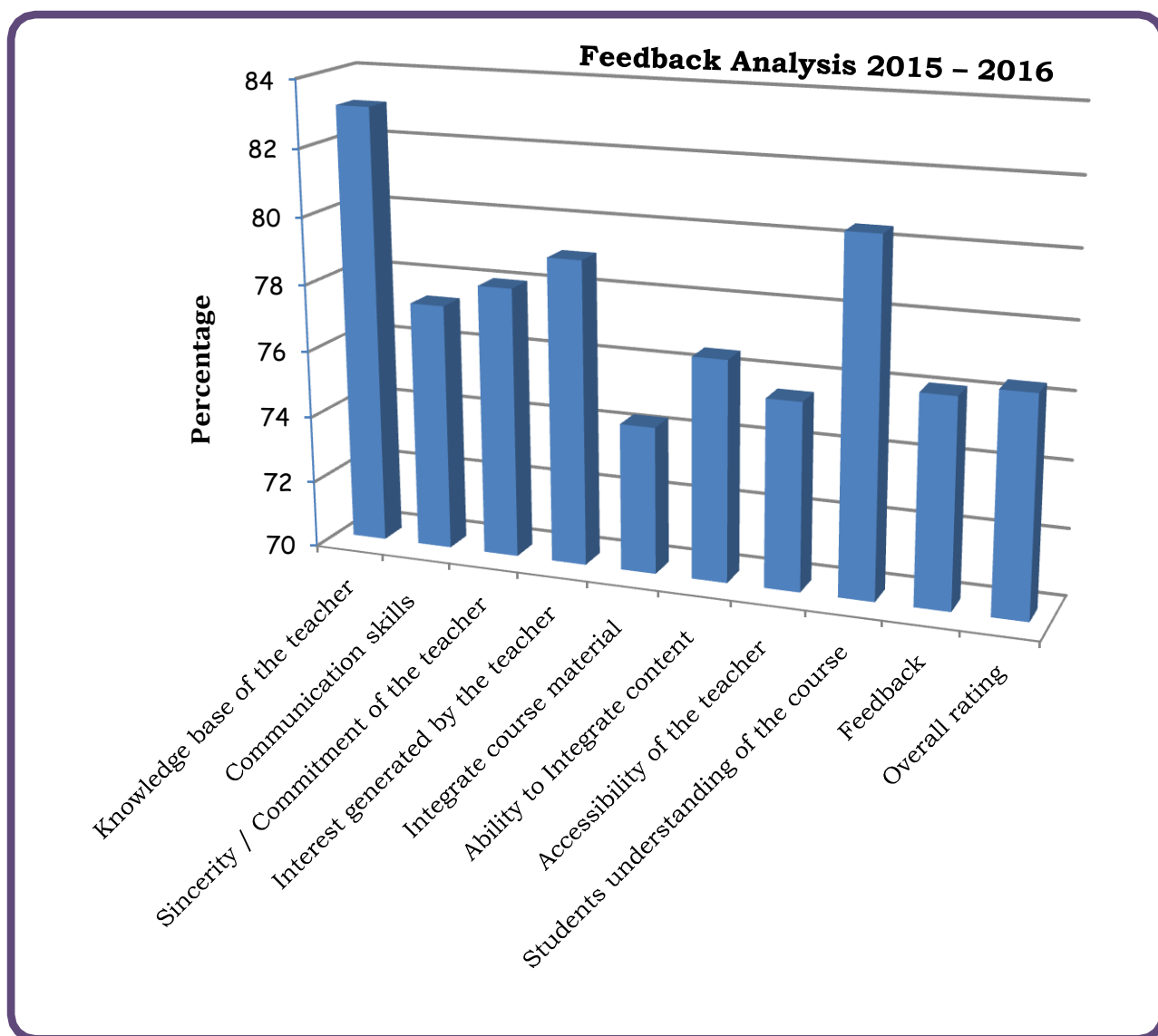

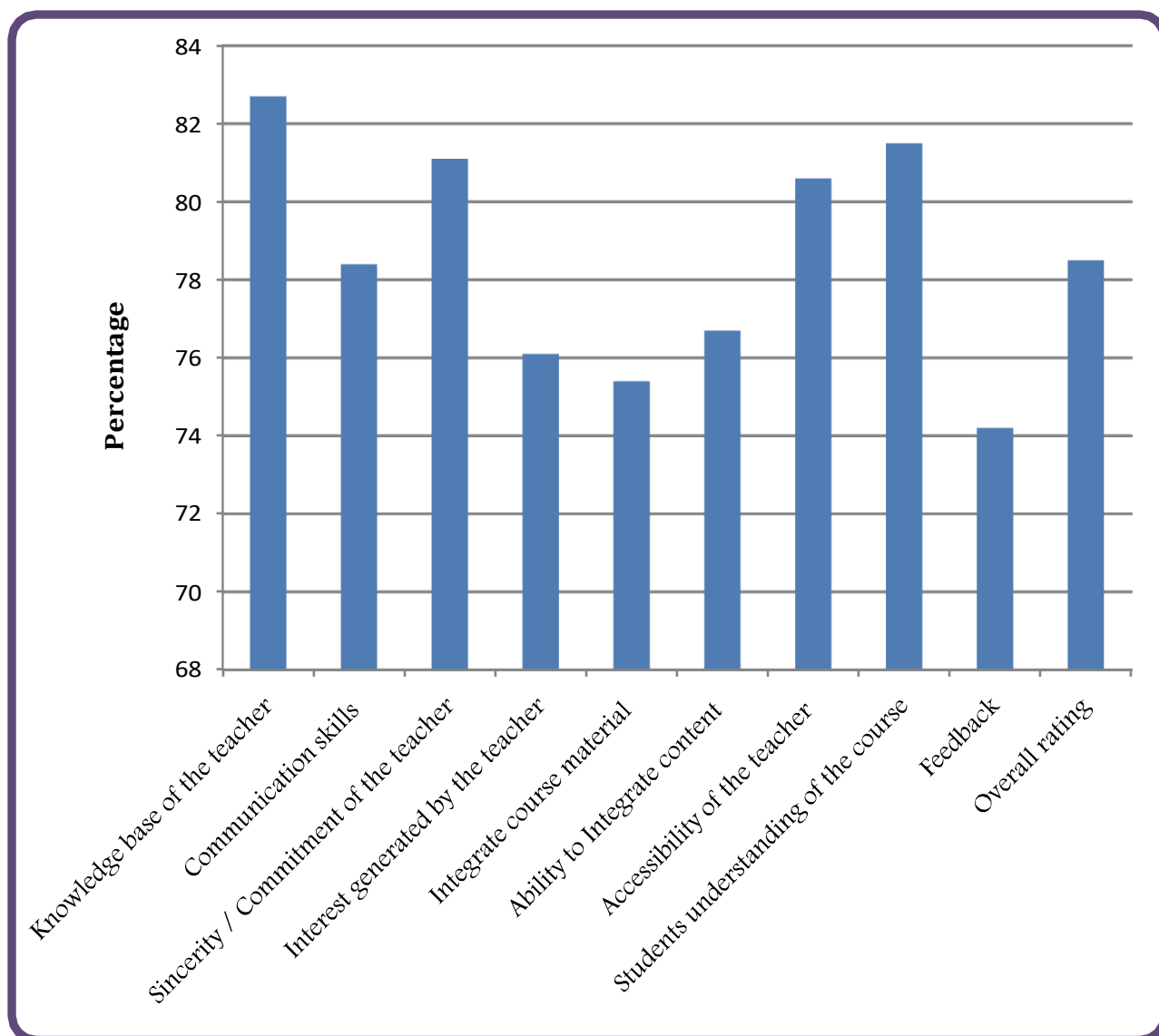

Preamble

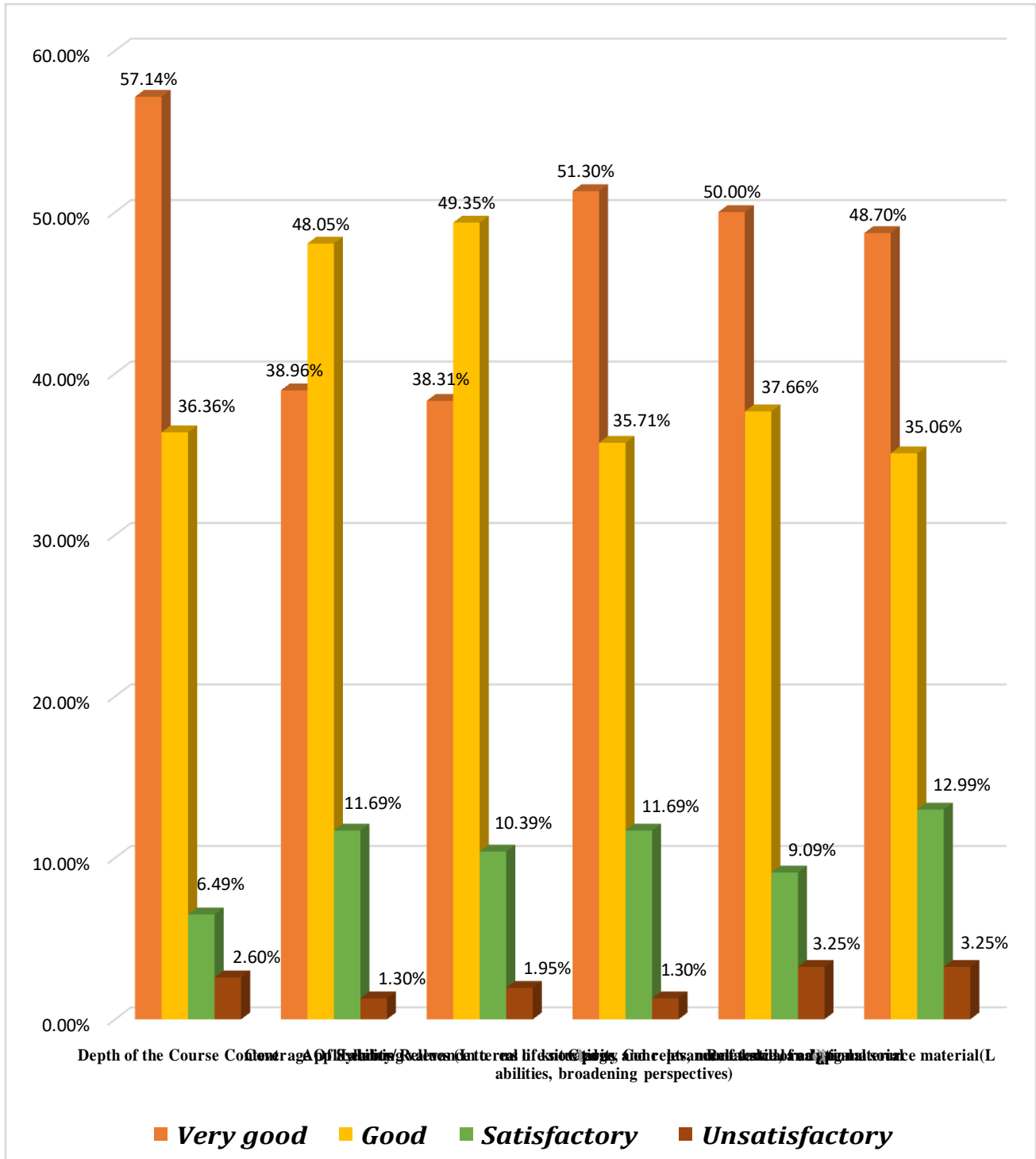

Majority of the students 66.23% have expressed that Professional knowledge, Practice and Engagement of Teachers. 57.14% of students are content with Curricular Aspects. 50.32% of students are satisfied with Library Resources and Infrastructure. 48.39% of students are happy with a Co-curricular programmes that help them boost up their moral values.

Students are extremely happy with coverage of syllabus and Applicability /relevance to real life. 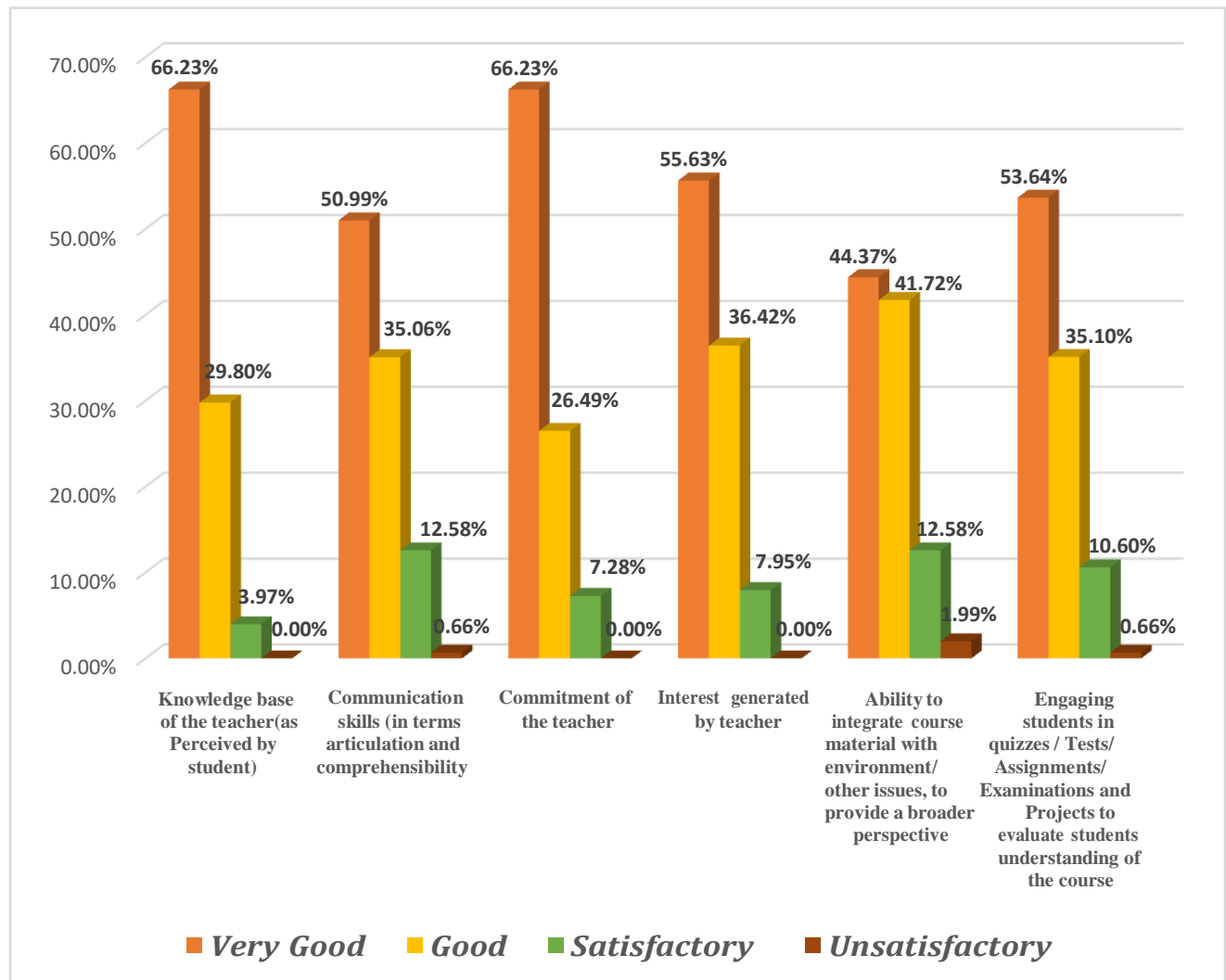
Fig. 1. Responses from students for curricular aspects

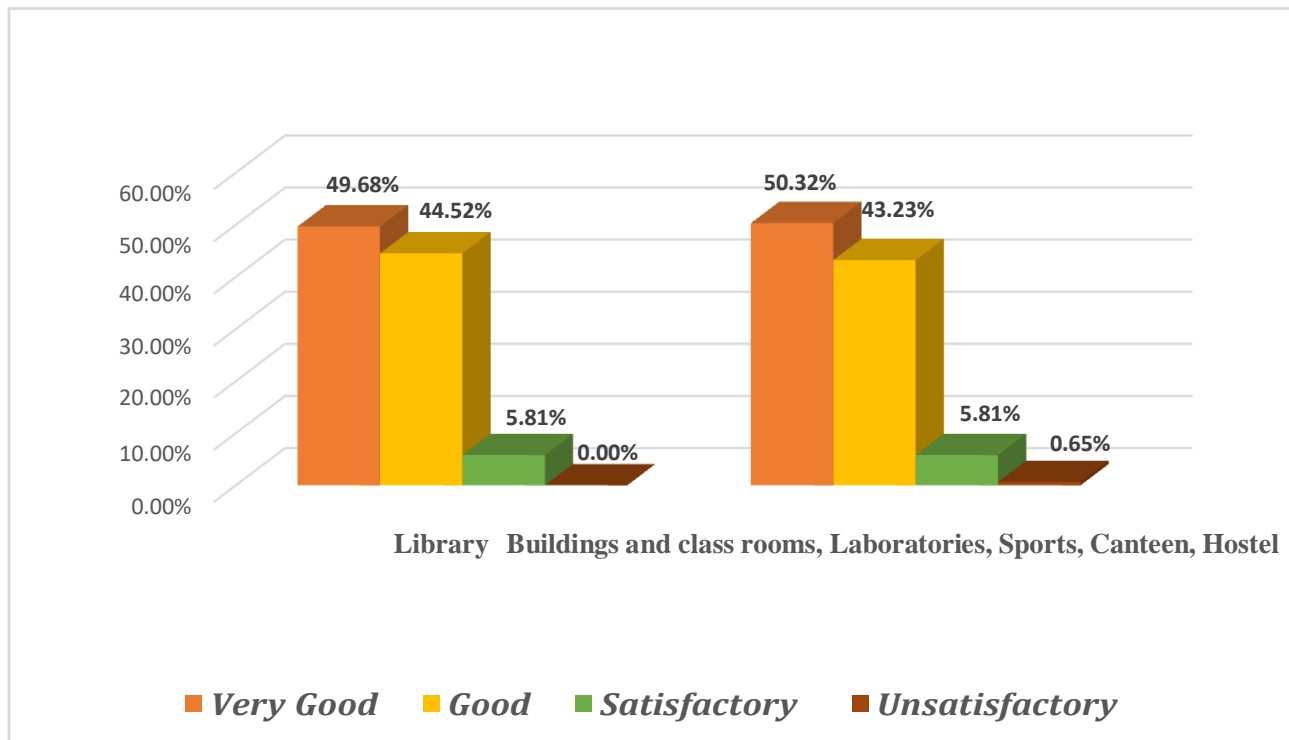
Fig. 2. Responses from students for Professional Knowledge, Practice and Engagement of Teachers

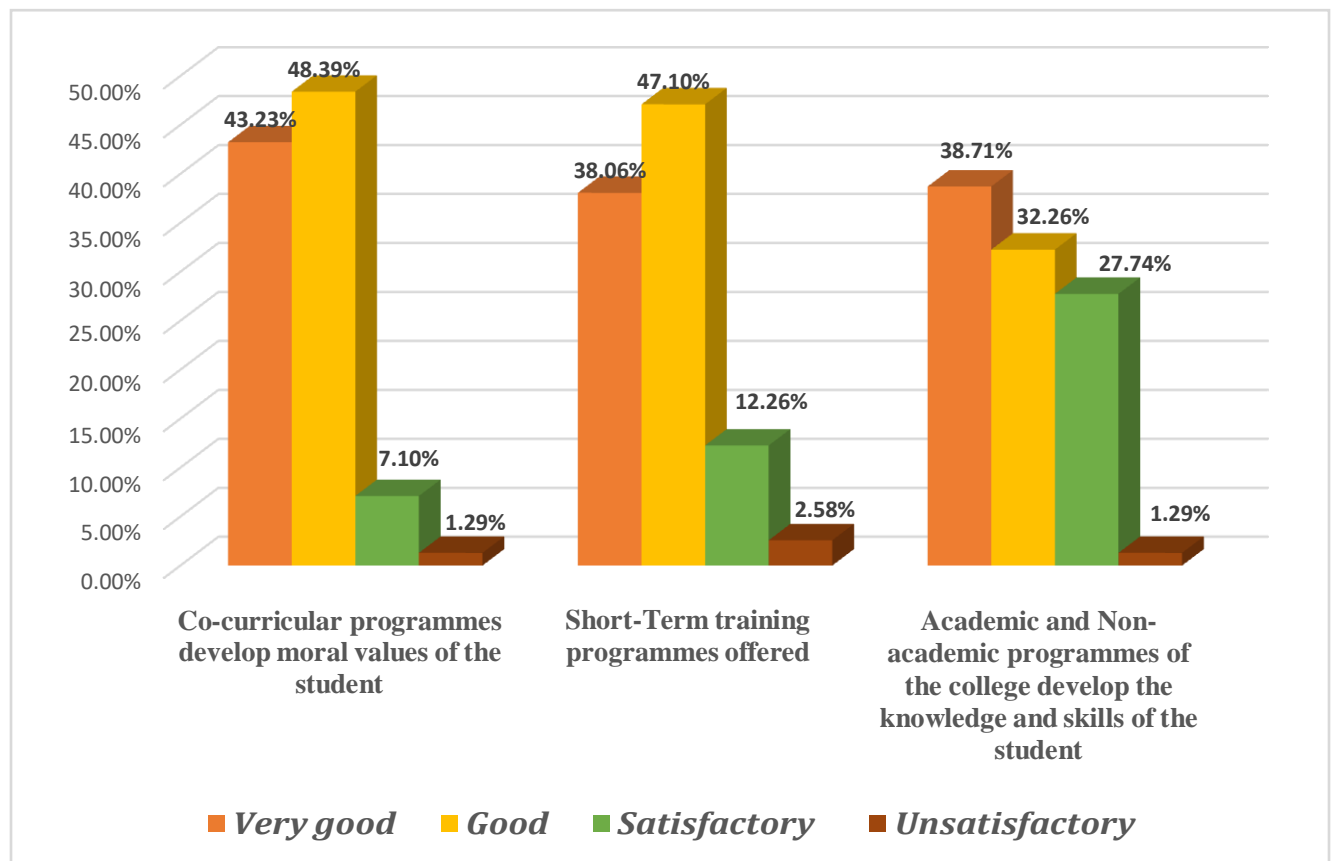
Fig. 3. Responses from students for library resources and infrastructure

Preamble

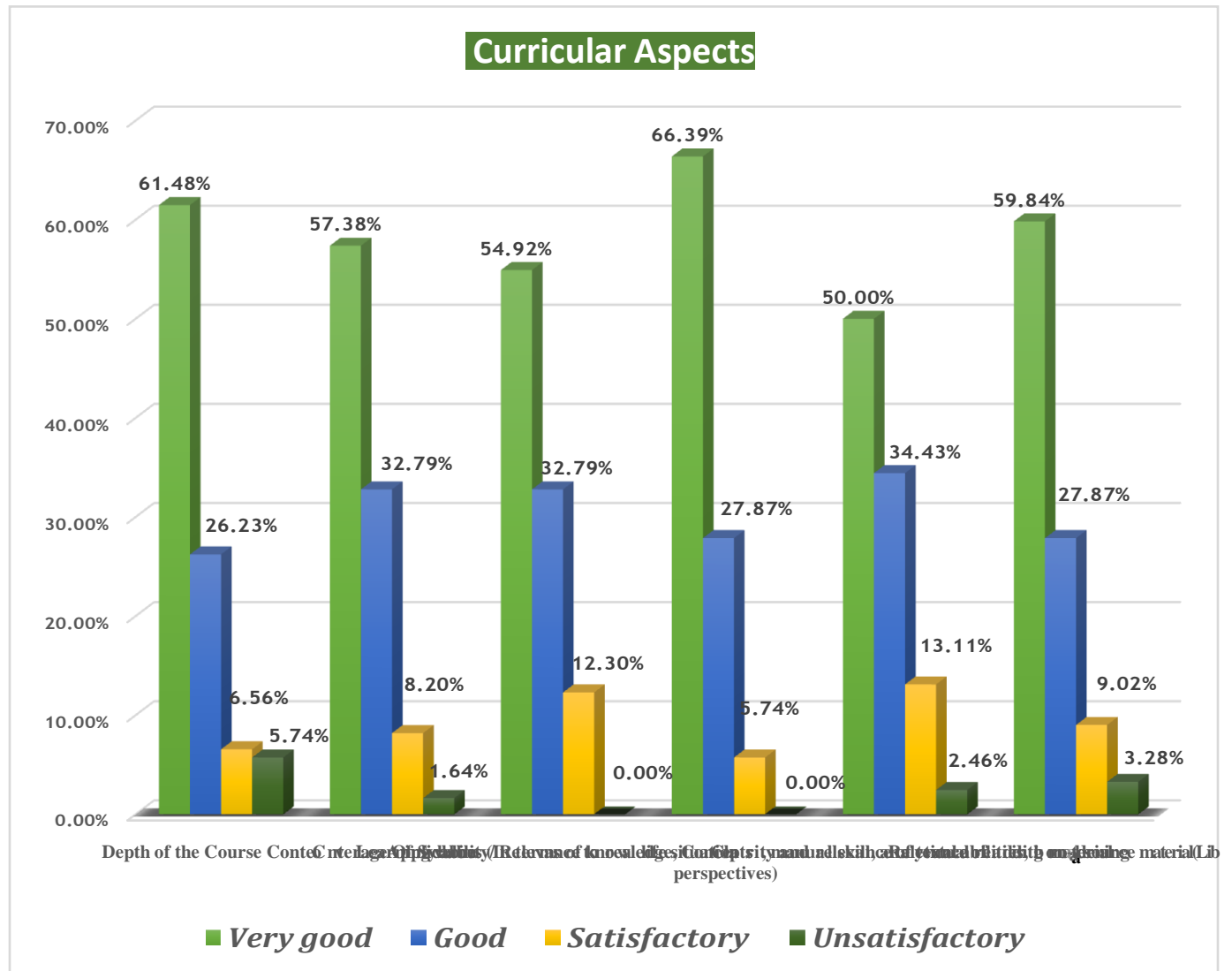
We carried out a survey to get suitable feedback on major aspects like curriculum, professional knowledge, practice and engagement of teachers, library resources and infrastructure, co-curricular programs, moral values, academic and non-academic programs of the college that develop the knowledge and skills.

Students handed back their suggestions and feedback during the PTA meeting. It is rated on a 4 point scale. A total of 400 students have taken up this survey. 77.38% have strongly expressed that Professional knowledge, Practice and Engagement of the faculty were the best. 43.12% of the students feel that buildings and class rooms, laboratories and infrastructure of the whole campus is good enough. Most of the students are satisfied with the clarity and relevance of the subject material.

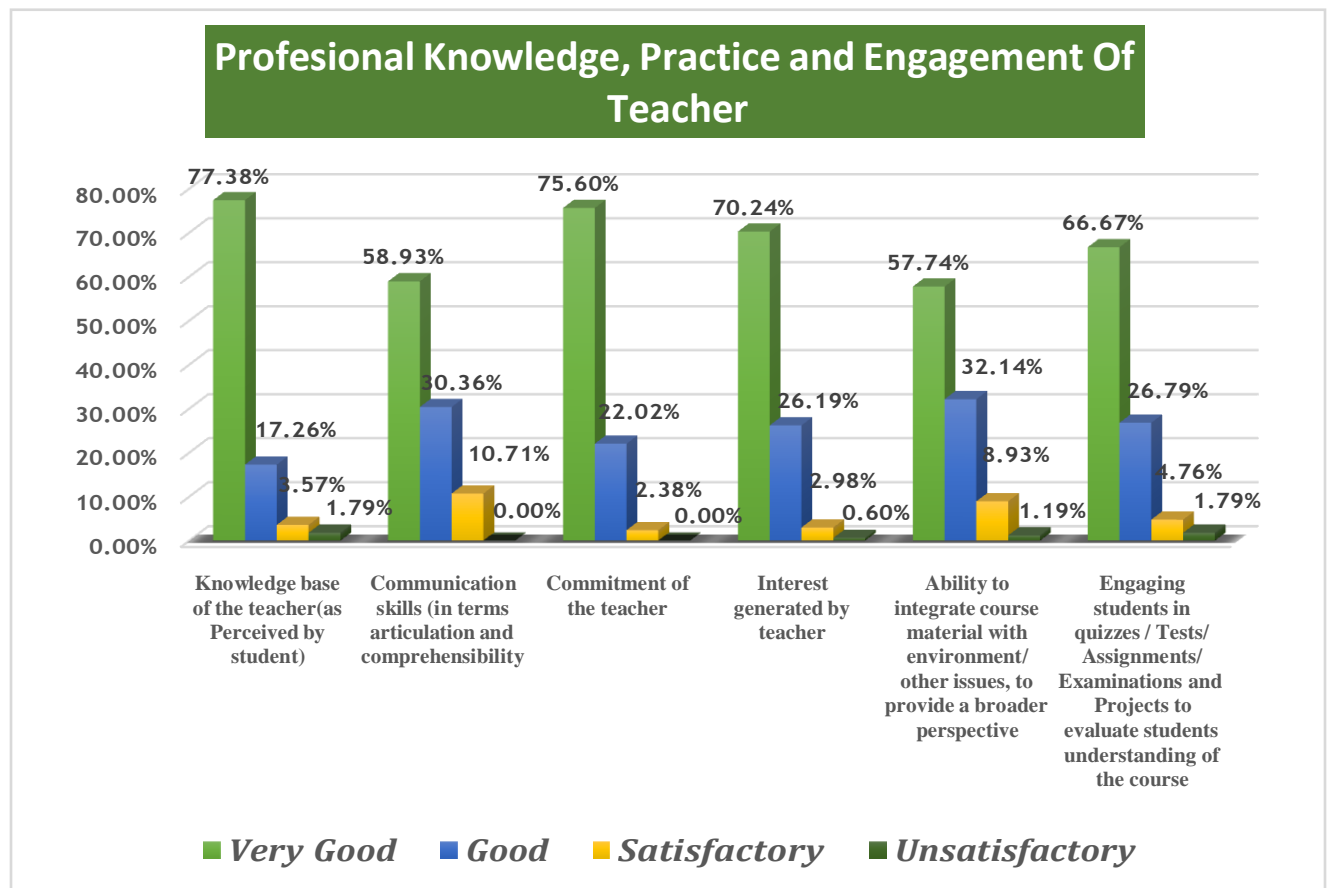
Fig. 1. Responses from students for curricular aspects

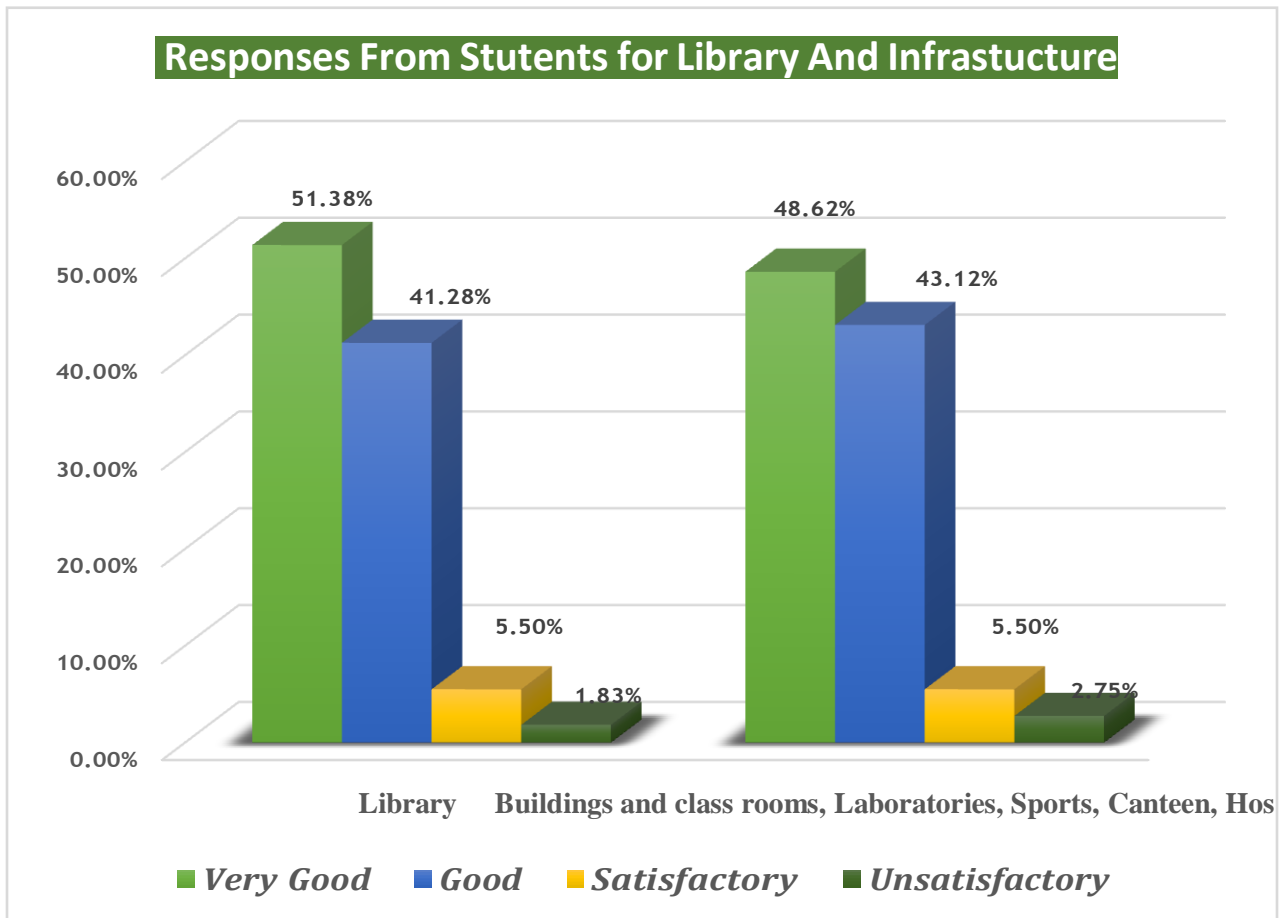
Fig. 2. Responses from students for Professional Knowledge, Practice and Engagement of Teachers

Many students are content with the availability of reference books from library and also with infrastructure of the college.

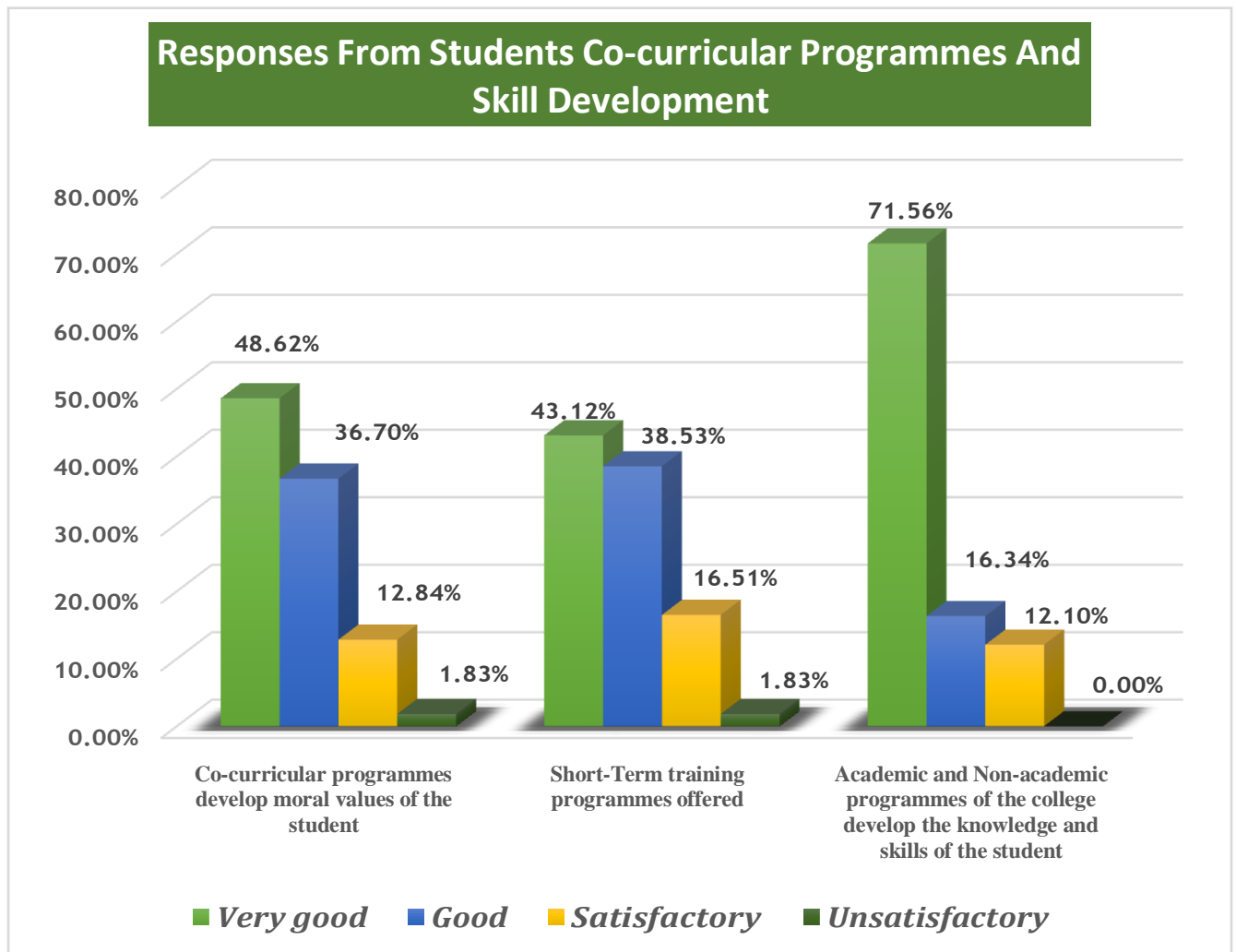
Fig. 3. Responses from students for library resources and infrastructure

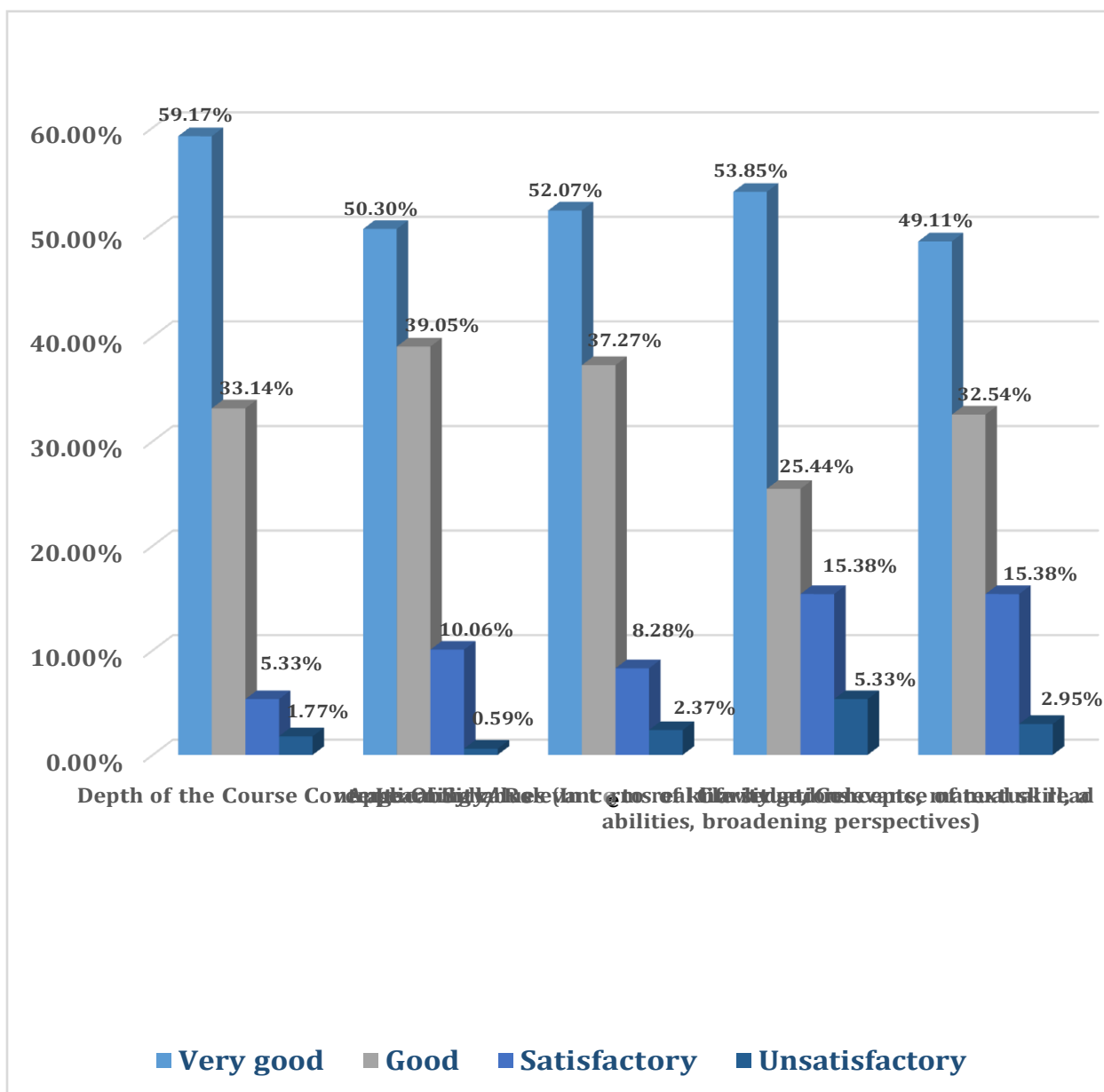

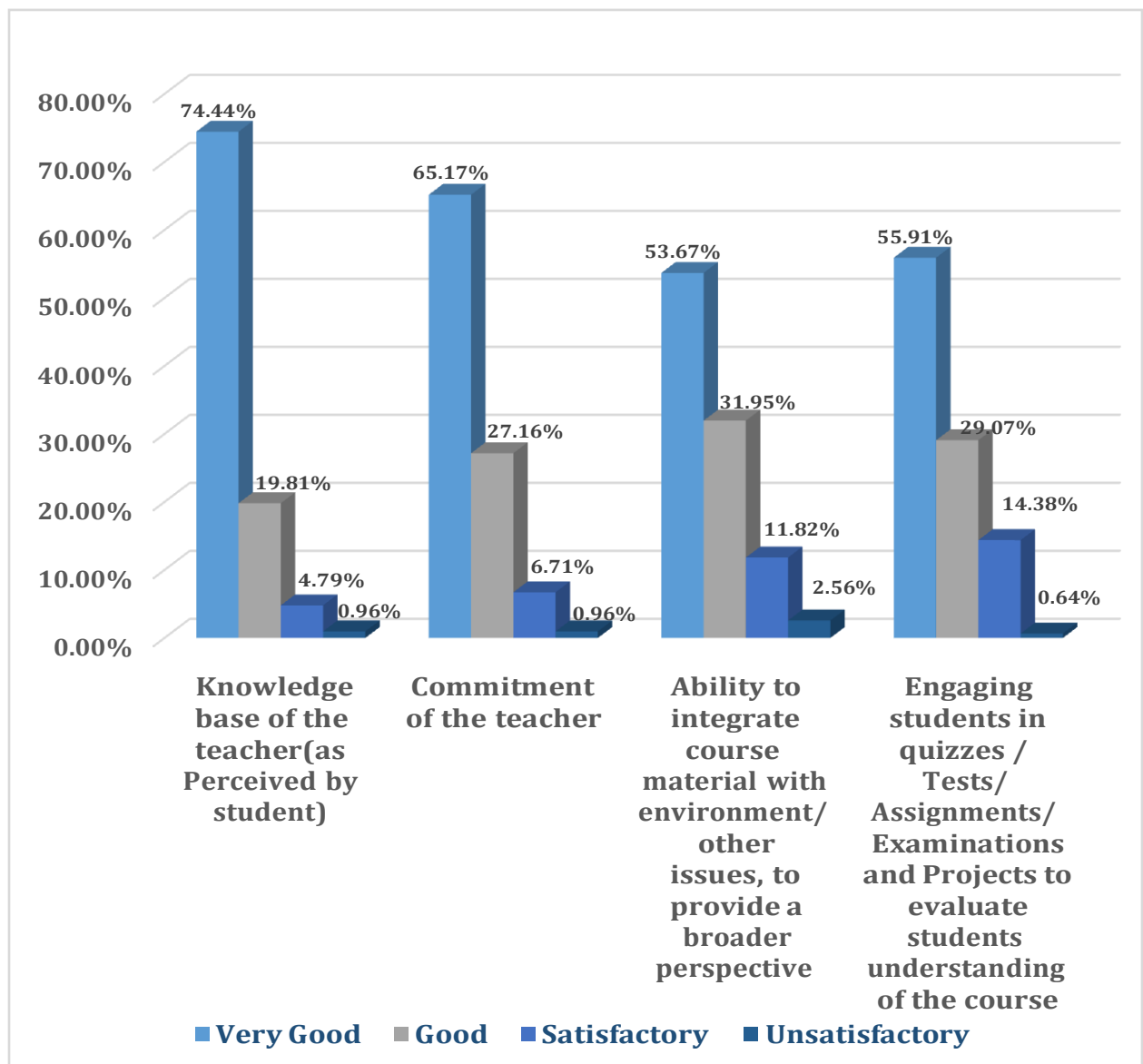
Fig. 1. Responses from students for curricular aspects

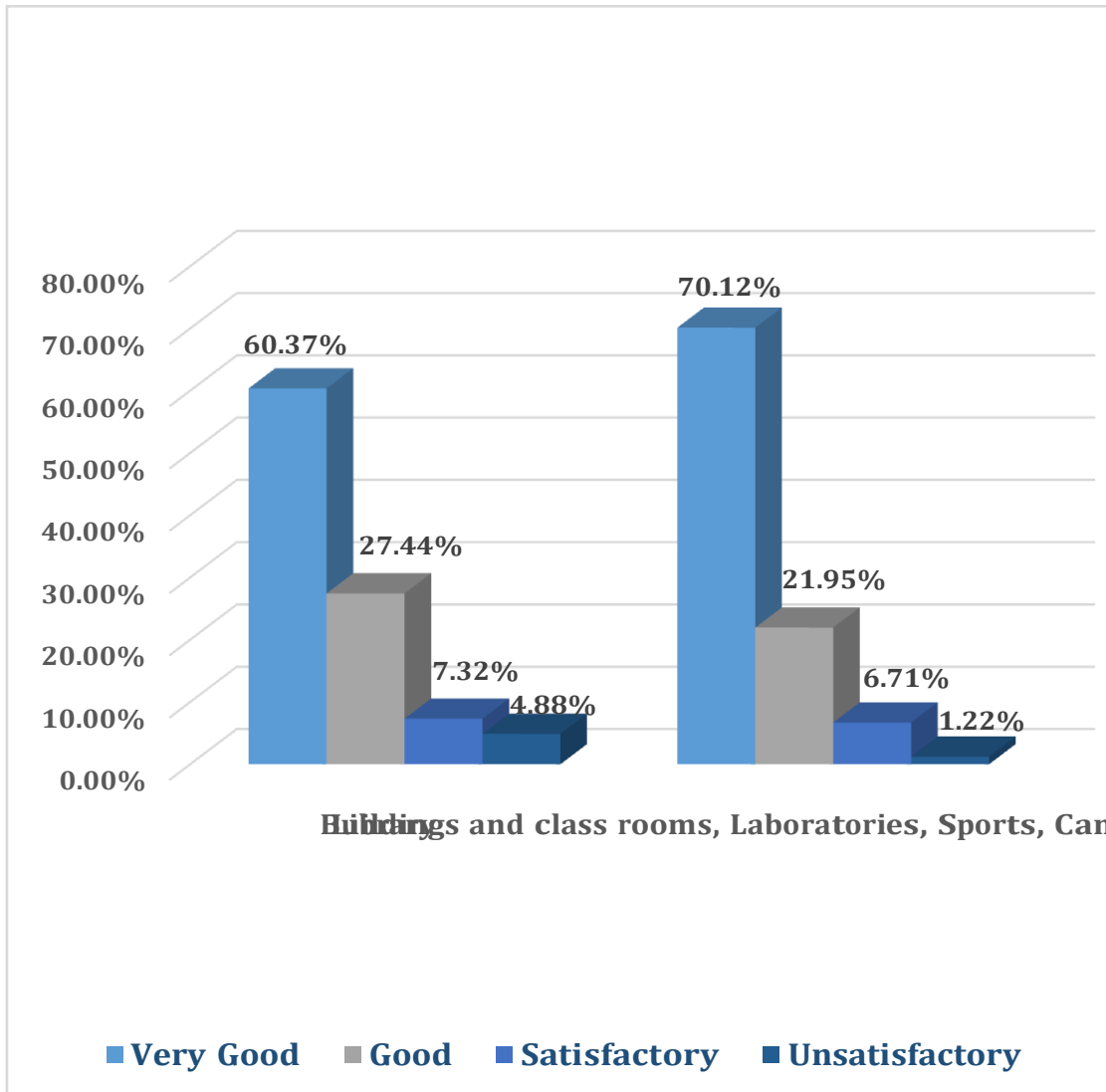
Fig. 2. Responses from students for Professional Knowledge, Practice and Engagement of Teachers

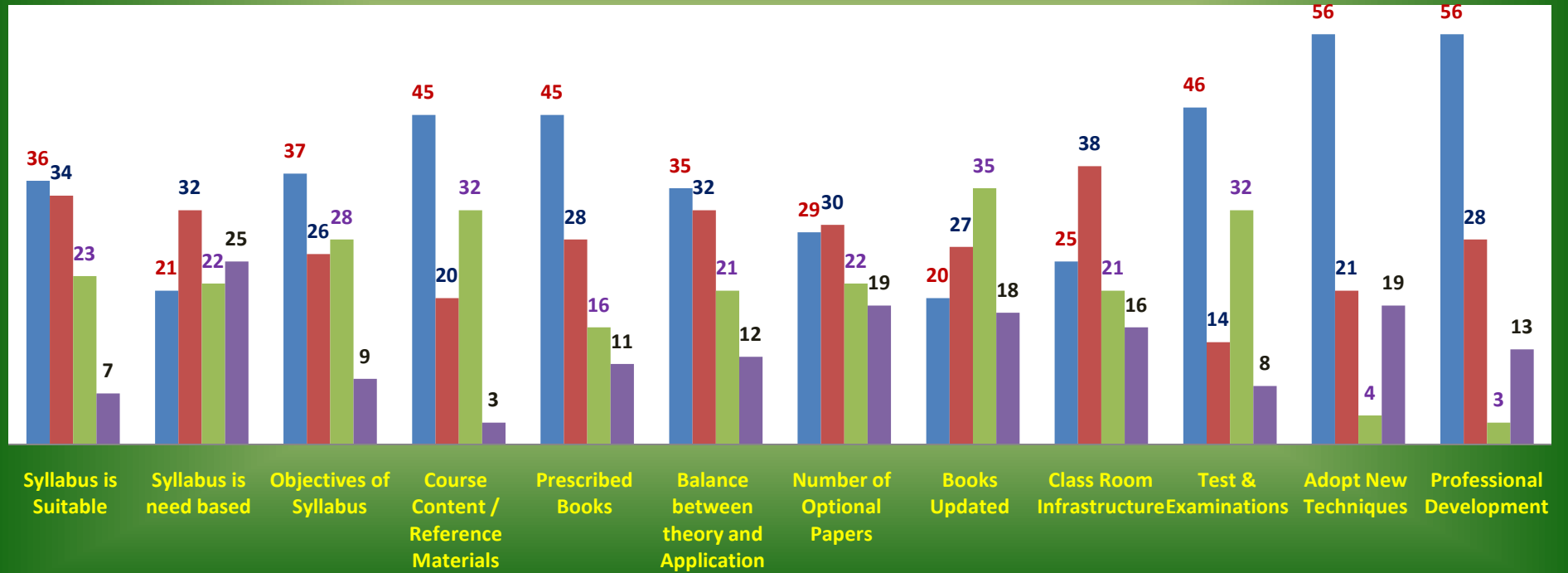

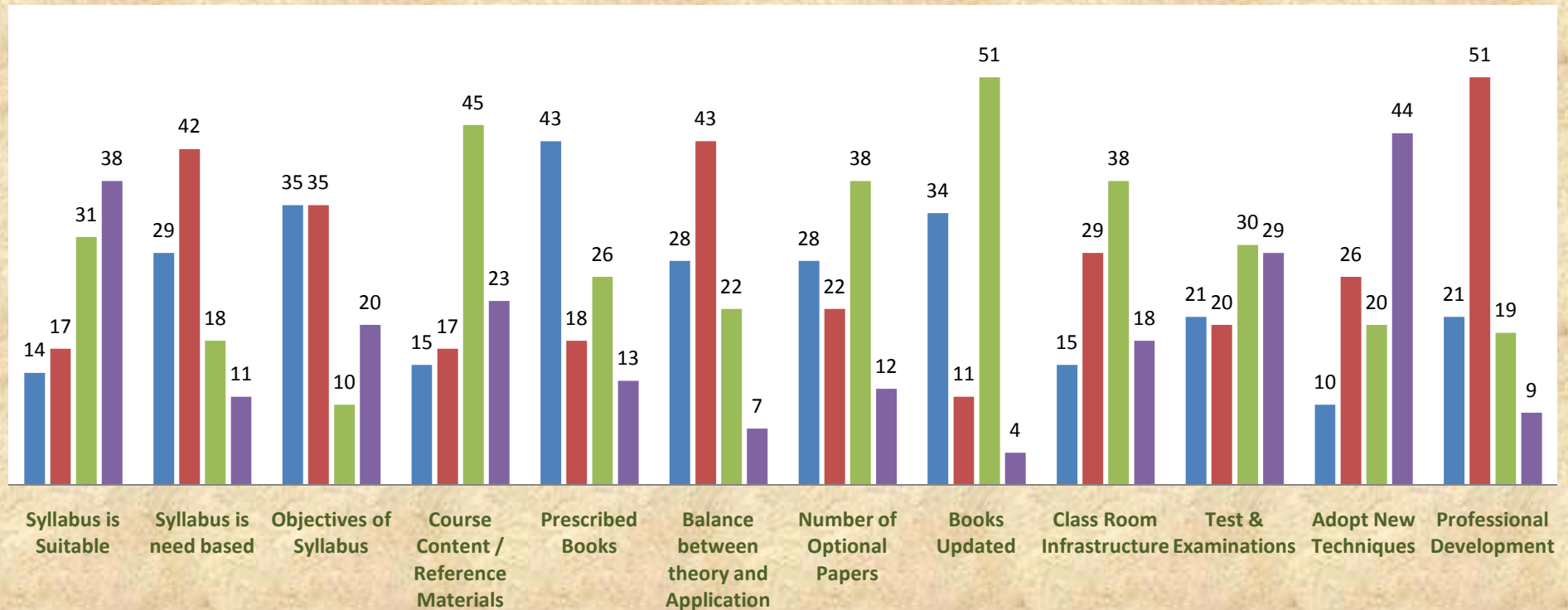

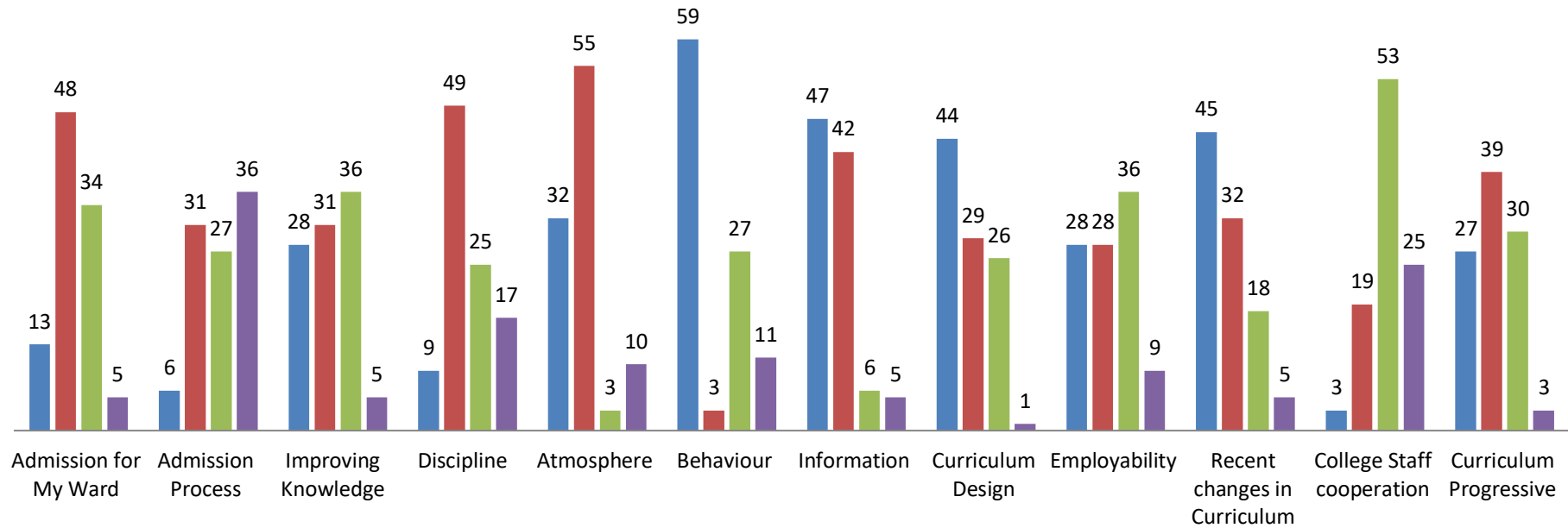

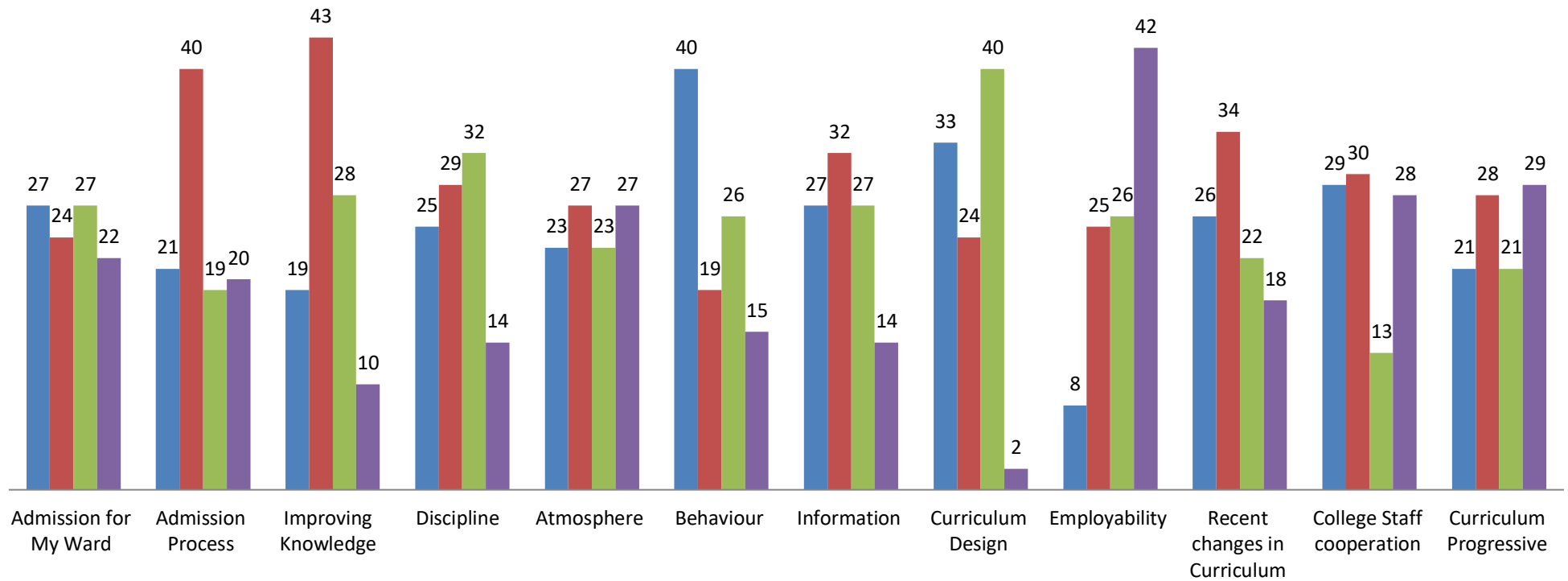

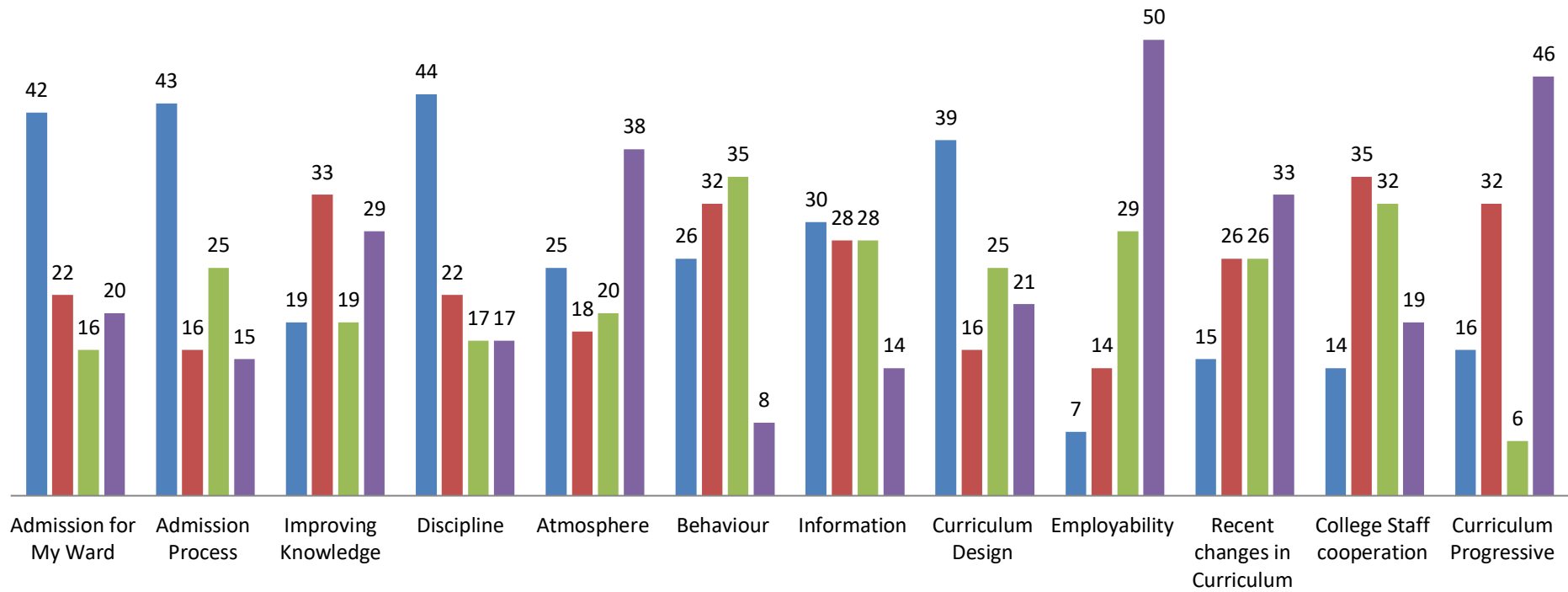

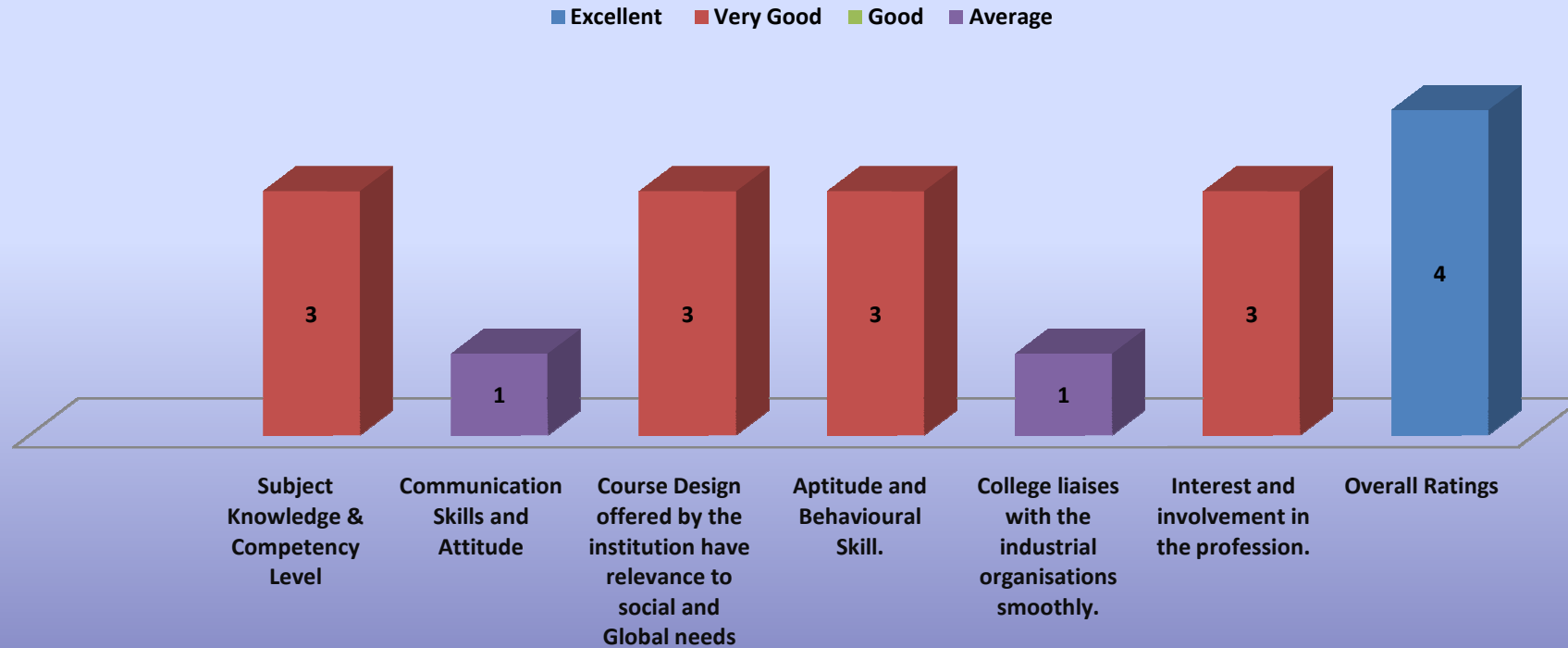
